

Brazil Industrial and Commercial Energy Storage EMS Management System

Can industrial battery energy storage systems be economically feasible in Brazil?

A literature review demonstrated that this paper is a pioneer in demonstrating such a high level of economic feasibility for industrial battery energy storage systems in Brazil. One year of primary data from the industry (historical load demand series) is made available through a GitHub repository so that results can be replicated.

What is an Energy Management System (EMS)?

Energy management systems (EMSs) are required to utilize energy storage effectively and safely as a flexible grid asset that can provide multiple grid services. An EMS needs to be able to accommodate a variety of use cases and regulatory environments.

What is EMS & how does it work?
The objective of the EMS is to shift and shave the electricity usage of consumers by charging and discharging the ESS to minimize their bills. The savings often come from demand charge reduction, time-of-use (TOU) energy charge reduction, and utilization of net-metering energy.

What are the components of a local EMS?

Just as an ESS includes many subsystems such as a storage device and a power conversion system (PCS), so too a local EMS has multiple components: a device management system (DMS), PCS control, and a communication system (see Figure 2). In this hierarchical architecture, operating data go from the bottom to the top while commands go top to bottom.
