

Can waterproof lockers be dismantled

You can't deconstruct them. If you don't want to keep them you can build a trashcan in your base and drop them there - they'll disappear after awhile.

Now that I have a base and a few lockers, I don't really need them anymore, and would really like to use the Titanium that I made them out of. Can I deconstruct them like I can do with various base pieces, ...

The Waterproof Locker can only be placed in the water and cannot be placed in a Seabase. When dropped, it floats in the water similarly to the Beacon and can store up to sixteen items in a 4x4 space.

Destroying waterproof lockers is possible, but it will cost you extra resources instead of reclaiming any spent on them. If you didn't build it with the Habitat Builder, you can't deconstruct it. So now you ...

Nope, you can't deconstruct waterproof lockers in Subnautica, but you can pick them up and redeploy them somewhere else.

I went out to look for more supplies for bleach and lube, and when I came back to retrieve some copper ore, I realized my Locker was completely gone! I looked outside and it didn't glitch out ...

Do Not feel like making lockers just to get rid of them. This might make more problems than it solves, but you can pick them up and transport them to the void (edge of the map) and drop ...

Nope, no deconstructing waterproof lockers in Subnautica. Just empty it and ditch it!

Yes, steel lockers can be disassembled and relocated. They are designed to be easily disassembled and reassembled, allowing for convenient relocation when needed.

You can dispose of the lockers via the Trashcan, but there is no way to recover the Titanium used to make them.

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
