



Does Botswana have 5G communication base stations

Orange Botswana is the first Orange affiliate to launch 5G, with a coverage of 30% of the population, including greater Gaborone and Francistown. Other cities will follow in early 2023.

After switching to 5G in Botswana, Orange plans to launch next-generation networks commercially in six other markets in the Middle East and Africa in 2023

5G is the fifth generation of mobile networks. Offering faster speeds than the current 4G, 5G is creating never-before seen opportunities for people and businesses.

Providers like YahClick (from Yahsat) or Intelsat offer enterprise VSAT connectivity in Botswana through local agents, albeit at higher cost and latency than Starlink. In addition, ...
