

# How many power stations are there in lesotho

In Lesotho there are six power stations: Two hydro-power stations ("Muela and Mantsonyane), a hybrid diesel-hydro power station in Semonkong, solar mini-grid at Moshoeshoe I international airport, ...

Like most countries in sub-Saharan Africa, Lesotho's fuel share of total final consumption is dominated by biofuels and waste at 57% followed by oil, 26%, electricity at 7% and coal at 7%.

Lesotho produces about 72 MW from hydropower (Meula). It has about 150 MW peak power and imports more than 70 MW mainly from Mozambique (29% of peak demand) and 20% of its peak demand ...
