The Serpa solar power plant is an 11 megawatt plant covered 150 acres (0.61 km²) and employs 52,000 PV panels. The panels are raised 2 meters off the ground thus allowing grazing to continue. The plant provides enough energy for 8,000 homes and saves an estimated 30,000 tonnes of carbon dioxide emissions per year. On 9 October 2021, the largest solar power plant in Portugal was inaugurated in Alcoutim
