Will Uzbekistan fund a 250-megawatt solar photovoltaic plant?

Tashkent, Uzbekistan, May 21, 2024 -- The World Bank Group, Abu Dhabi Future Energy Company PJSC (Masdar), and the Government of Uzbekistan have signed a financial package to fund a 250-megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic plant with a 63-MW battery energy storage system (BESS).

How can Uzbekistan support its energy transition?

To support Uzbekistan's energy transition through the expansion of solar photovoltaic (PV) installed capacity.

How will Uzbekistan improve its energy security?

"This project will enhance Uzbekistan's energy security through the use of innovative solutions and technologies," noted Marco Mantovanelli, World Bank Country Manager for Uzbekistan.

How many solar power plants are there in Samarkand?

The Project involves the design, financing, construction, ownership, operation, and maintenance of three solar photovoltaic independent power plants representing a combined 897 megawatt (MW) of installed capacity (Samarkand 220MW plant, Jizzakh 220MW plant and Sherabad 456.7MW plant) (the PV plants), and their associated interconnection facilities.

In 2025, Uzbekistan paid UZS 209.2bn (\$16.7mn) in subsidies to 45,381 households for rooftop solar electricity fed into the national grid, with the largest allocations going to Khorezm, ...
